This arrangement was made initially for eight harp parts and performed on an historic broadcast of the BBC programme "Songs of Praise" for the beginning of the New Millennium, 2000. This is the longest running religious programme on UK television. The venue was the new Millennium Stadium, Cardiff Arms Park – the home of Welsh rugby; officially, one hundred harps took part, although there were actually one hundred and five! The harp ensemble comprised students, former students and associates of Coleg Telyn Cymru (*The Welsh Harp College*, a seasonal residential course for students worldwide), while other guests included The Band of the Welsh Guards, Daniel O'Donnell, Laura Michelle Kelly, Sir Cliff Richard, Noel Richards, Bryn Terfel and Andrew Lloyd Webber, together with the "BBC Choir of Choirs": five thousand three hundred singers in all!
