INTRODUCTION

Harpists are often asked to play popular melodies at functions, be they ceremonies, receptions, weddings or official dinners. In this collection of ten popular English tunes, each may be played individually or all ten as a medley, lasting about fifteen minutes; performed as such, the harpist should please everyone, since each member of the audience will have their favourites.

Being the third volume in my series "Top Ten Traditional Tunes", it follows on from "Top Ten Welsh Traditional Tunes" and "Top Ten Scottish Traditional Tunes". These arrangements are suitable for both pedal and lever harp, lever changes inserted with the complete performance in mind. On the other hand, if the tunes are played singly, the levers and pedals should be prepared for the particular key required at the beginning of each one.

I sincerely hope that performing these arrangements will give you as much pleasure as I have had researching the rich and diverse repertoire of English melodies.

Meinir Heulyn is one of Wales' most proficient and versatile harpists and is at the forefront of the Welsh harp scene. Having graduated from University College, Cardiff, she continued her harp studies at the Conservatorio di Musica, Genova.
